



## ***Mommy and Me Class Descriptions***

Mommy & Me continues to expand and additional classes are now being offered. All classes are taught by Kim Singer M. Ed, a State Certified Teacher of the Deaf and Parent/Infant Specialist. Come and see what so many area families are enjoying. All religious denominations are welcome and encouraged.

Class descriptions are as follows:

**Mommy and Me:** For ages 6-11 months: This one hour class features a stimulating circle time as well as a developmental theme appropriate for the babies. A wide variety of center activities aimed at developing newly emerging motor and cognitive skills are addressed.

**Mommy and Me:** For ages 12-24 months. Each theme-based class features a highly interactive circle time, as well as activities related to the theme designed to target a wide array of developmental milestones. Art, sensory, fine/gross motor activities are standard parts of this one hour weekly class. Music and movement, story-time and snack round out this action packed hour. You will leave each class armed with new ideas to interact with your child.

**Toddler 2's and 3's:** This growing class is for children ages 2 and up. Each theme-based class provides many opportunities for language and activities designed to challenge your child's growing cognitive abilities. This class provides an opportunity for your older toddler to socialize in a stimulating pre-academic environment. This class meets either once or twice a week for 1 1/2 hours each week.

**Baby Signs:** American Sign Language (ASL) is a fast growing language. There is a multitude of research touting the benefits of signing with your baby. If you are looking to communicate with your preverbal baby, then this is the class for you. Each six week semester covers signs relevant to your child's routine. As a Teacher of the Deaf, only ASL signs are used-no invented signs. Using signs is linked to increased verbal skills, higher I.Q.'s and alleviates baby's frustration at not being able to communicate. You will learn how to sign popular songs and read classic books to your child in ASL. Please contact Kim Singer to schedule a baby sign class for your friends and family.
